Common Stage Vocabulary

- In-Studio run-through:** a rehearsal done in the studio that is a full run through but without costumes
- Costume rehearsal:** a rehearsal in the studio that is a full run through done with costumes
- Dress rehearsal:** a rehearsal done in the theatre with full lights, scenery, costumes, etc. We will stop and start as needed but with hopefully less than a tech rehearsal.
- Call:** The time when a dancer is required to be at the theatre.
- Act I:** The first half of the show
- Act II:** The second half of the show
- Intermission:** Half time

Costume and Hair Requirements

- Please let us know if you need to borrow a dress code leotard that is a camisole or tank. A camisole leotard is one with thin straps.
- **Dancers that need pink trunks need to provide their own.**

Dressing Room Procedures

- Children need to be signed in and out by ONE parent. There is a desk in the hallway where they will be met by a backstage helper and then taken to the dressing room.
- Children will be taken care of by our backstage helpers. All backstage helpers are background checked.
- **Parents who are NOT backstage helpers are NOT allowed in the dressing room OR backstage. This includes during ALL rehearsals.**
- Gossiping and rude parents will be asked to leave. We do not have the time for this behavior.
- Please arrive ON TIME already wearing dress code leotard and tights with street clothes pulled over.
- Please come already wearing blush, eye shadow, and mascara.
- Wee Mice and dancers only in ACT I MUST be signed out by one parent during intermission only.
- All dancers must be wearing street clothes to be dismissed (street clothes worn over a leotard and tights).
- **No students will be released in the middle of the show. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- All students are expected to be on their best behavior while at the theatre.

- Children are NOT allowed to leave the dressing room while still in costume.
- Please remember that we are not your personal maids. Clean up after yourselves. This means all Band-Aid wrappers, food wrappers, bottles, etc. should be either thrown in the garbage or recycled.

What to Bring

- Ballet shoes, jazz shoes, character shoes, and/or pointe shoes (as needed)
- 2 pairs of tights (one for emergencies)
- 2 dress code leotards (one for emergencies)
- **A hair kit packed with lots of bobby pins, two hair nets, and thick hair elastics**
- A brush
- Hair spray
- Safety pins
- Something to wear over leotard and tights such as zipped sweatshirt and sweatpants
- Water bottle filled with water
- Underwear for later
- A healthy snack that is NOT messy
- Deodorant (if needed)
- Foot care supply kit (if needed) packed with Band-Aids, toe tape, lamb's wool, Neosporin, etc.
- Toe pads, spacers, etc. (if needed)
- Small sewing kit (if needed)
- A quiet game, cards, books, or coloring books and crayons to pass the time
- **PLEASE write your name on all belongings!**
- A blanket is very handy and highly recommended

What NOT to Bring

- **Valuables**
- Markers
- Fast food
- Messy snacks such as Cheetos, Oreos, blueberries, Playa Bowls, etc.

Makeup

All students, including boys, will need makeup to brighten their faces under the stage lights

- Pink blush for cheeks
- Black mascara
- Brown eye shadow
- NO glitter makeup, NO glitter hairspray

NEW THIS YEAR: we have makeup and hair kits available for younger dancers for \$5. Please buy these at the studio ahead of time.

If you come without supplies, we will be charging your \$10 per instance.

Nails and Jewelry

- No nail polish or French tips allowed-please take it off the Sunday before and leave it off.
- Please do not put on temporary tattoos during the week of Nutcracker.
- Please do not apply any spray or artificial tanners the week of the show.
- Students may wear **small** clear rhinestone earrings only (no dangles). However, if a girl is cast as a boy, toy, or animal, she should not wear earrings for that part. NO earrings for Wee Mice, Rag Dolls (boys), Toy Soldiers, Sergeants, Captains, Fritz, Fritz' Friends, Party Boys, Lambs.
- No other jewelry allowed.
- Please, no glitter is needed, even if you receive it as a gift.

Hair

Unless specified all female dancers need to wear hair in a classical bun worn flat to the middle of the head.

- NO BUNMAKERS or donut things allowed for hair.
- Use a spray bottle of water if needed to wet down hair.
- Pull hair straight back to put into a ponytail at the crown of the head.
- Coil hair into a bun shape.
- **Use a hair net (the same color as hair) to hold all hair together.**
- Pin around the bun using lots of bobby pins so that bun is flat to the head.
- Hair spray the finished product so there are no wispsies.
- **Bangs for all dancers must be pinned and sprayed back.**
- No colored or shiny clips, barrettes, or bun covers are allowed.
- All headpieces (flowers, ribbons, hats, etc.) MUST be pinned in a crisscross fashion. Give it a little tug to make sure it is secure.
- Please pick up a sheet on how to make a classical bun if you are uncertain how to do this, attend a bun making class or check our YouTube channel: You may also access this information on our You Tube channel at <https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCI-uS24nnpn7tqLwwqdxRpPw>
- *You can also find ringlet and makeup tutorial information here.
- Most hair supplies can be purchased at Walgreens, Walmart, Amazon, Penny Robin Dancewear etc. (Remember we can't personally guarantee which store has what items - we suggest you shop early!)
- You are responsible for purchasing your own hair supplies.
- **NEW THIS YEAR: we have hair kits available for younger dancers for \$5. Please buy these at the studio ahead of time.**
- Each child needs to have her own brush. PLEASE DO NOT share brushes or other hair supplies.
- No feathers allowed in hair or tinsel allowed in hair.
- **No artificial hair colors**

Last year, some parents did not have the correct supplies for buns and our volunteers provided a lot of the necessary bun items out of their own pocket. This year, if you do not have the right items and we must supply them, we will charge a \$10 fee to your account per instance.

Name Tags

- Please make sure you have put your child's name on leotards, tights, shoes, and other belongings (especially dance shoes). We have a lot of children performing and things can easily get misplaced.

Tights and Shoes

- All younger female dancers need clean pink ballet shoes with elastics **sewn** on (many shoes come with the elastics pre-sewn but if they are not you will need to make sure the elastic is properly sewn on).
- All boys will need white tights and black ballet shoes with elastics sewn on.
- Drawstrings **MUST** be tucked in.
- All female ballet dancers will need clean light pink nylon footed (with the feet) **dance** tights with no holes or runs (except Toy Soldiers). We suggest getting nylon tights because they wash well and don't snag easily. Also, they won't "shine" under the lights.
- All dancers on pointe **must** hair spray, tape, or sew their ribbons in. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- **Dancers on pointe will be fined if their ribbons come out on stage at the rate of \$5 per teacher on our faculty.**
- **Girls: Please do not wear panties (underwear) underneath tights. It is not necessary and creates excess lines.**
- **Dancers on pointe need to wear their tights INSIDE their shoes, meaning we should not see any skin. If you prefer, you need to sew your tights to your pointe shoes. See the tutorial here: <https://www.youtube.com/shorts/GIbXN0yN1NM>**

Costumes

- Dancers are not allowed to keep any costume.
- Please make sure that you treat every costume with respect. All dancers in Ballet 1 and higher will be taught how to and then be expected to hang up their own costumes if needed. If a dancer is caught being careless with a costume, he or she will be responsible for the dry cleaning and/or repair costs of the costume.
- Dancers who need it **MUST** wear deodorant.
- **NO ONE IS ALLOWED TO EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING EXCEPT WATER WHILE IN COSTUME!**

Volunteers

- We always need volunteers for performances. We have sent out a link to our online Sign-Up Genius.
- All volunteers will be expected to be calm, courteous, and follow the rules and vibe of the lead volunteer.
- Volunteers who want to be in charge or **cannot follow directions will be dismissed.**
- All volunteers who are working with children must be background checked. Please let us know if you need the link to be background checked.

- YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO WATCH THE SHOW FROM BACKSTAGE so if you want to watch the show, please buy a ticket instead.
- USHERS-you are not there to watch the show but make sure people get seated, assist them in case there is a problem or medical emergency, and make sure that no one is illegally recording the performance. For this reason, please do not bring children with you. You must arrive early to help seat people. If you are late, you will be required to buy a ticket instead.
- We also need donations of concession items such as cookies, brownies (these should be store bought this year). Please put snacks in individual Ziploc bags so we can distribute them easily (or buy them already in small bags). We are also allowed to sell small bottles of water, soda, and other pre-packaged snacks as well as hot chocolate and coffee. Thanks.

Parental Behavior

- Please treat our volunteers, faculty, directors, and staff with respect during the rehearsals and performances. **Please be respectful.** Anyone caught yelling at a volunteer, staff, director, or faculty member will be dismissed from the school and all fees will be forfeit.
- Gossiping and nasty behavior will NOT be tolerated.
- Let's make this a wonderful experience for everyone!

NOTE: There is NO Potluck Dinner between the shows on Saturday and Sunday again this year. There are lots of options available on Sheridan Blvd and further west on Wadsworth Blvd. or bring your own food.

Photography

- There will be a photographer taking pictures during the dress rehearsals and performances. These will be provided to you in December. The media fees will automatically be charged to the card on file for all Nutcracker families on December 10th. (this is a fee per family and not per dancer).
- Please do not post any pictures on social media sites without explicitly asking the people in the picture. We have students who are not allowed to be photographed in the cast.
- NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY is ALLOWED IN THE AUDIENCE! It is harmful to the dancers AND audience members. We have a dancer in the cast as well as a few known members of the audience with seizure disorders and the sudden flash could trigger a seizure. This includes the dress rehearsal. This will be strictly enforced.

Videos

Candidly Created will be recording The Nutcracker.

NO ONE IS ALLOWED to record the performance! Ushers and our staff will be enforcing this rule.

Tuition

- All tuition INCLUDING tuition for the month of the December MUST be paid before the performance or your child will not be allowed to perform! There are NO reductions or prorates on tuition for ANY reason.

Parking

- Parking is free for the Joanna Ramsey Theatre.

Volunteers

- We will need volunteers for performances. The Sign-Up Genius will be sent separately.
- If you help backstage, PLEASE understand you will NOT get to watch the show that you are helping with.
- When ushering you are expected to help patrons find their seats and assist them if needed, including during the show. You cannot bring your children with you. We suggest watching one show with your family and then helping at additional shows.
- When volunteering please remember that you are helping ALL children, not just your own. Thanks for understanding this.
